

Miller Analogies Test (MAT)
Information Sheet
(Computerized Version)

1. Auburn University at Montgomery is a Certified Testing Center of The Psychological Corporation for the MAT.
2. The computerized version of the MAT is administered Monday thru Thursday during the hours of 8:30 a.m. thru 3:30 p.m. The test will take approximately 1 (one) hour to complete. You must reserve a date and time in advance of the date you wish to test on.
3. The registration fee is \$75.00 and can be paid by check or money order. Reservations may be made by visiting the Psychology Department, Goodwyn Hall - Room 210 or by phone at 334-244-3306. You can also submit your registration fee through the mail. Please include the time and date you prefer for testing. This can be mailed to the address at the bottom of the page.
4. Payment methods are check or Money Order. Checks should be made payable to: **Center for Psychological Services.**
5. At the time of testing, you **must** present a current Driver's License for verification of identification purposes.
6. If you cancel your testing date you will be required to submit a request for the refund in writing which should include a brief explanation of why you are requesting the refund. Only \$37.50 will be refunded due to administrative costs in processing the payment and refund. If you wish to reschedule your testing date, this must be done at least one day prior to your scheduled testing date. If you reschedule at least one day prior to the testing date you will be rescheduled at no extra charge. If you do not reschedule prior to the testing there will be a \$37.50 rescheduling fee.
7. To obtain a Candidate Information Booklet you can go to www.MillerAnalogies.com to request a booklet or to download a booklet. Practice tests are also available at this website.
8. You are allowed to have The Psychological Corporation report your results to three schools. This is included in the registration fee. Additional schools or later reports can be added through The Psychological Corporation with an additional fee to be paid to them. When taking the computerized version of the MAT you will receive an unofficial test score upon completion of the test. Official results will be mailed to you from The Psychological Corporation.
9. A study guide, **How to Prepare for the MAT** by Barron, can be purchased at the AUM Bookstore, or at one of the larger booksellers in Montgomery.
